1) Preparation for NET/SLET Examination

- **Introduction:-**

Today's world is the world of L.P.G. (Liberalization, Privatization, and Globalization). In this world competition is everywhere and education faculty is not an exception to it. If the students just pass out the M. Ed. Exam they will be unable to get the good job because after the completion of M. Ed. Exam. for teaching at the B.Ed. College the UGC has made compulsory to pass NET/SET few norms and NET/SLET is very important among them. For that purpose our college organized 15 days workshop for M.Ed. students.

- **Objectives:-**

1. To remove the fear about NET/SLET examination and create the confidence to win it.
2. To aware them about the nature of NET/SLET examination.
3. To aware them about the passing criteria for NET/SLET examination.
4. To acquaint them with the syllabus of NET/SLET examination.
5. To provide the question pattern.
6. To provide the skills to solve the question papers I, II, and III.
7. To prepare the model question paper of NET/SLET examination to solve the students.
8. To encourage them for the study of NET/SLET examination.

- **Procedure**

The workshop was arranged at the R. C. Patel College of Education Shirpur. The workshop was arranged for fifteen days. The workshop was organized in the month of October so that it will be helpful for forthcoming NET/SLET examination in December.

In the beginning our eminent lecturers made acquainted the students with the syllabus, nature, and passing criteria of the NET/SLET examination to remove the fear from their mind. This was continued till two days.

After the introduction of syllabus, nature, and passing criteria of the NET/SLET examination plan of action for the students was prepared. Three days were assigned for the preparation of paper I. In these three days 10 units of this paper were taught and discussed with the students and model question as well as answers were given to the students.

For second paper guest lecturers were invited who were expert in the relevant subjects such as Philosophy, Sociology, Psychology, Research etc. These expert taught the theory of the paper second as well as handled two tests based on the topics taught by them.

The paper III of NET/SLET examination contains 10 units, 5electives and 1 broad question related with current issues in the field of education. For teaching each unit and electives the experts of that relevant subject were invited by the college.

The workshop was successes fully continued till 15 days . After that we arranged a practice NET/SLET examination. Then we divided the students into 5 groups. Each group of students was provided the set of NET/SET exam books. Each group consists of

10 students and a lecturer to solve their problems and help them. Pre-exam of the students was conducted on 20th December 2010 prior to 27th December's actual NET/SLET examination

- **Major Findings**

1. It really helped to remove the fear about NET/SLET examination from the students mind.
2. It helped to create the healthy environment for NET/SLET examination.
3. Students face the NET/SLET examination without stress.
4. Students learnt to manage the time and speed of writing during the NET/SLET examination.
5. Students were ensured that they would definitely pass out the forthcoming NET/SLET examination.
6. Three student pass in SLET Exam.
7. Two student pass in NET Examination Dec. 2010.
